Digitizing Global Trade - A public-private partnership of BMZ and DPDHL

The Digitizing Global Trade Project is an Alliance partner project of the German Federal Ministry for Economic Cooperation and Development (BMZ) and Deutsche Post DHL Group (DPDHL). It aims to modernize international trade by adding digital solutions to enhance efficiency and reduce risk and will be implemented initially in 5–6 countries starting in 2021. As part of a larger strategic cooperation spanning 10 years, this Alliance partner project will eventually be rolled out to up to 30 countries worldwide. This session will provide first insights on the project approach and participants can expect a fruitful discussion amongst experts.
